The International Ethno cultural Festival "Nomad Universe" includes a cultural program of the Third World Nomad Games. All interested countries are invited to participate in the International Ethno cultural Festival "Nomad Universe".

ABOUT THE WORLD NOMAD GAMES

The World Nomad Games are the biggest international project held in the Kyrgyz Republic, a project initiated by the government in 2012 for the revival and preservation of the culture of nomadic civilization.

The First World Nomad Games were held from September 9th through 14th, 2014, in Cholpon-Ata, in the Issyk-Kul Province of Kyrgyzstan. 583 athletes from 19 countries participated in competitions held in 10 types of sports, plus an additional 1,200 participants in the cultural program. The television broadcast of the Games reached 230 million people.

The Second World Nomad Games were held from September 3rd through 8th, 2016, in Cholpon-Ata, in the Issyk-Kul Province of Kyrgyzstan. 1,200 athletes from 62 countries participated in competitions in 26 types of ethnosports, which were broadcast to 500 million people.

The opening ceremony of the Third World Nomad Games is planned for September 2nd, 2018, in Cholpon-Ata, in the Issyk-Kul Province of Kyrgyzstan. The competitions themselves will be held in five locations.

3,000 athletes from 77 countries are expected to participate in competitions in 37 types of ethnosports.

MISSION OF THE THIRD WORLD NOMAD GAMES

The World Nomad Games are aimed at developing the ethnosport and ethnoculture movement in the world, as this is the heritage of human civilization.

The mission of the World Nomad Games covers the revival, development and preservation of the ethnoculture, diversity and originality of the people of the world in order to foster a more tolerant and open relationship between people. The slogan of the Third World Nomad Games is “United in Strength! United in Spirit!”.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE THIRD WORLD NOMAD GAMES

- Preserving the cultural and historical heritage and diversity of peoples from around the world in the era of globalization;
- Developing the world ethnosport movement;
- Popularizing, developing and promoting ethnosports at the world level, including traditional games and competitions from around the world;
- Support for the scientific and methodological foundation of the ethnosport movement, including ethnosports, traditional games, and traditional competitions;
- Strengthening and further developing interfaith and intercultural dialogue, understanding, friendship, harmony, and cooperation between the people of the world, and demonstrating the cultural diversity of the world.

Special attention at the World Nomad Games is paid to ecology. The official mascot of the World Nomad Games is the snow leopard. The organizers of the Games hope to bring extra attention to the plight of the snow leopard and to saving the habitat of this unique animal.

FEATURES OF THE THIRD WORLD NOMAD GAMES

The 2018 World Nomad Games feature three main parts:

- Ethnoculture
- Ethnosport
- Science

OBJECTIVES OF THE ETHNO-FESTIVAL

- Preservation of the ethno cultural heritage of nomadic people as an integral part of the world civilization.
- Development, popularization and promotion of ethno cultural traditions of nomadic people and ethnos of the world at the international level as part of global ethno cultural movement in the era of globalization.

EVENTS AND DATES OF ETHNO-FESTIVAL

Foreign artistic groups, artists and culture professionals are welcome to participate in the following events of the Ethno-Festival:

1. Ethno-hit (folklore and variety art);
2. Ethno-dances;
3. Ethno-fashion;
4. Ethno-bazaar (exhibition-fair);
5. Narrative art (epics, legends);
6. Ethno-house (dwelling of nomads).

The program of the Ethno-Festival also includes a demonstration of a participating country its national cultural program, reflecting national history, culture and traditional life.

Dates of the event: from 2nd to 8th September 2018.

Location and sites: Isyk-Kul region, Kyrgyz Republic

- The Central racecourse of Cholpon-Ata city.
- The "Kyrchyn" gorge.

CONDITIONS

All participants arrive in Bishkek on September 1, leave on September 9th. All participants are provided with viza, all internal transfers, accommodation and meals at the hotel on Lake Issyk-Kul.

PROGRAM

The festival programs are organized at two concert venues (the Central racecourse of Cholpon-Ata city, the "Kyrchyn" gorge). Performances of groups and individual performers will be organized according to the schedule from September 3 to September 7. The participants can prepare from 1 up to 5 ethnic shows on stages. The festival will be closed on September 8th. All participants will be awarded with unique statuettes and certificates of «World Folk Vision», as well as prizes of the “Nomadic Games” .

«Ethno-hit»

The music of the people of the world is a great legacy transmitted by word of mouth and reflecting the culture of the people, its vision of the world, its history, its way of life and aesthetic ideas. Each nation has its characteristic songs, improvisations, teachings, instructions.

The event is aimed to widely popularize diverse music culture and songs of the world.

Folklore and ethnographic ensembles, individual performers of folk songs and instrumental music, as well as performers of variety songs (members of the cultural delegations) are invited to the event "Ethno-Hit".

The event "Ethno-Hit" includes the performance of folk instrumental music, folk and pop songs that reflect the history, culture and way of life of the people of the participating country.

Performers will play 2 songs:

- Song in ethno-style
- Hit of the country

The use of the phonogram "-1" is allowed.

«Ethno-dance»

Traditional national dance is an integral part of the ethnic culture of each nation. This type program of the event will be devoted to the demonstration of original ethnoses of different people of the world. At the event "Ethno-dance", participation of both a soloist and a dance ensemble are welcomed (performed by members of a cultural delegation). The program of the performance could include ritual dances, folk dances, as well as dances reflecting the history, traditional culture and way of life.

«Ethno-fashion»

The national costume of nomad people is part of the material culture of nomads, and it is the ethno-fashion of modern individual that reflects the dialogue between generations and representatives of different national and cultural communities.

In the event of Ethno-fashion, designers of clothes of the members countries of the Third World Nomad Games and individuals (members of cultural delegation) are invited to participate, with collections of traditional national costumes or creating modern clothes, using "ethnic" embroidery.

The minimum collection should include 10 units. An exhibition-fair of clothes will be held within the frames of the Ethno-Fashion event.

«Ethno-Bazaar»

Traditional crafts are an important component of the intangible cultural heritage of nomad culture. From ancient times nomads are well known for their handicrafts. Using local natural materials, they used to produce fine carpets, exquisite jewelry, household products, as well as horse and military equipment.

Handicraft of world's nomad people will be presented at the exhibition-fair and at master-classes during "Ethno- bazaar". Exhibitors should present products that reflect the culture, traditions and way of life of their nation.

Narrative art (Epics, Legends)

Epics and legends of the peoples of the world are transferred from generation to generation. The event is aimed to develop and promote the mastery of oral narration of world's epics.

At the event participants dressed in national costumes, will demonstrate their performing, improvisational skills and eloquence (members of cultural delegation).

Ethno-House (Dwelling of Nomads)

At "Kyrchyn" gorge site participating countries can install yurts, tents, and light temporary national dwellings that were traditionally used at nomadic times. The participation in this event is optional.

Also, historical items traditionally used by ancient nomads can be exhibited at the event.
